Here are the specific plans we will keep in place for our re-opening.

Revised Reopening Plan June 2, 2021

1. **Date-** Indoor services scheduled to resume July 4, 2021.
2. **Social Distancing-** All seats will be spaced 3 feet apart. Socializing should occur outside the building. The Pastor will remain at the chancel throughout the service until all who attended have left the sanctuary.
3. **Masks-** All persons who are not fully vaccinated in accordance with CDC guidelines are strongly encouraged to have their masks on throughout the service, and as they enter and leave the building. Extra masks will be available for those who need them.
4. **Bulletins-** Bulletins will be prepared before the service and left on the seats for attendees to bring home.
5. **Sanitizing-** Touchless sanitizers will be at the entranceways, and doors and frequently touched surfaces will be treated with "NanoSeptic" self-cleaning products.
6. **Communion-** On Sundays when there is communion, those attending the service will find communion kits on their seats.
7. **Offering-** A box for the offering will be placed at the back of the sanctuary.
8. **Bathrooms-** Bathrooms will be open for those attending the service. Touchless soap and paper towel dispensers will be available, along with "NanoSeptic" self-cleaning products and touchless trash receptacles.
9. **Water-** The water dispenser in the back of the sanctuary will not be available. Persons will be advised to bring their own water to church. There will be no coffee hour.
10. **Cleaning-** The sanctuary and bathrooms will be cleaned after the service. The Atlantic Korean Presbyterian Church will be asked to resume their services in the afternoon.
